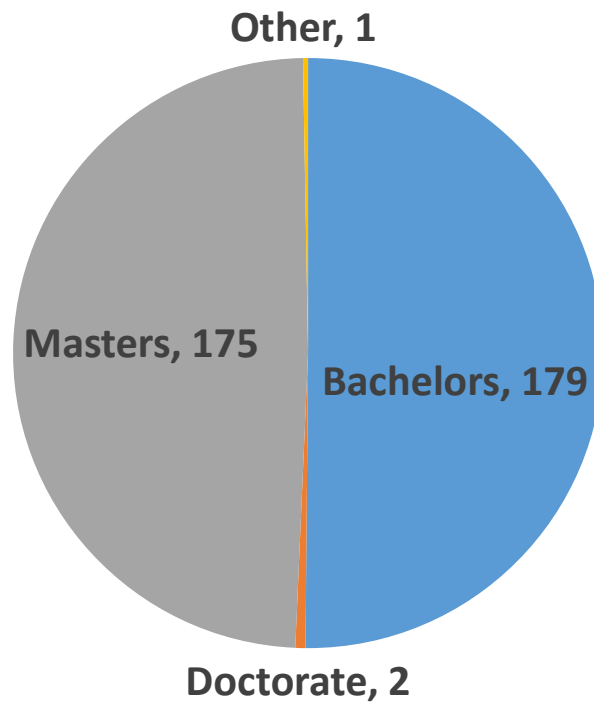
Count of Year of study



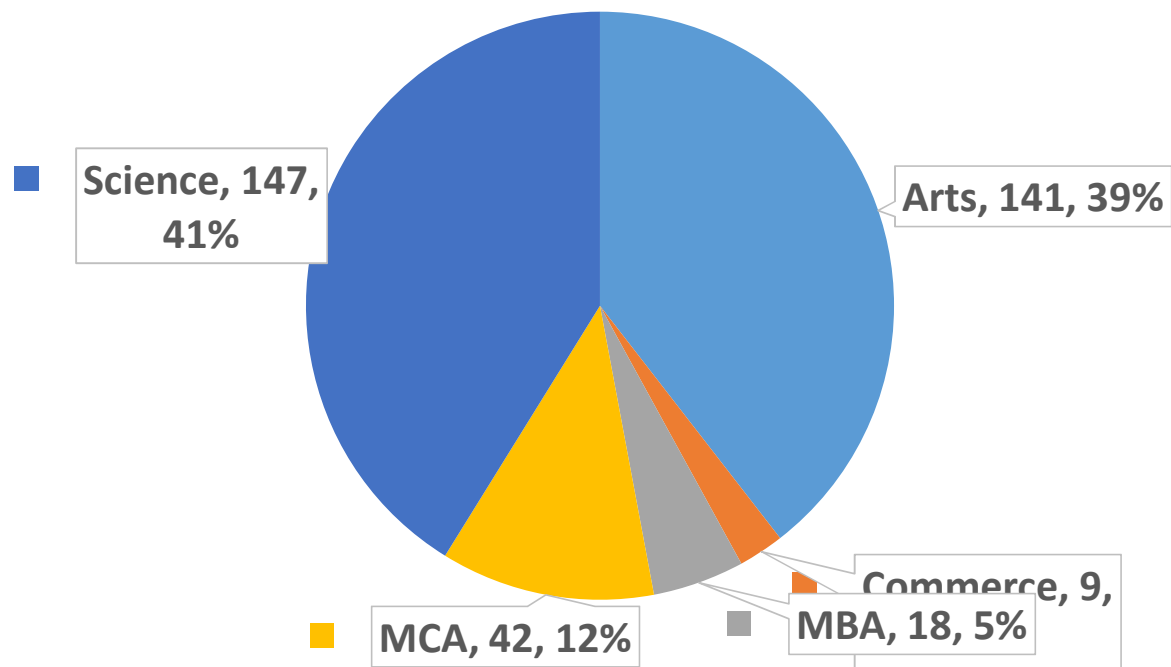
Count of D) Gender



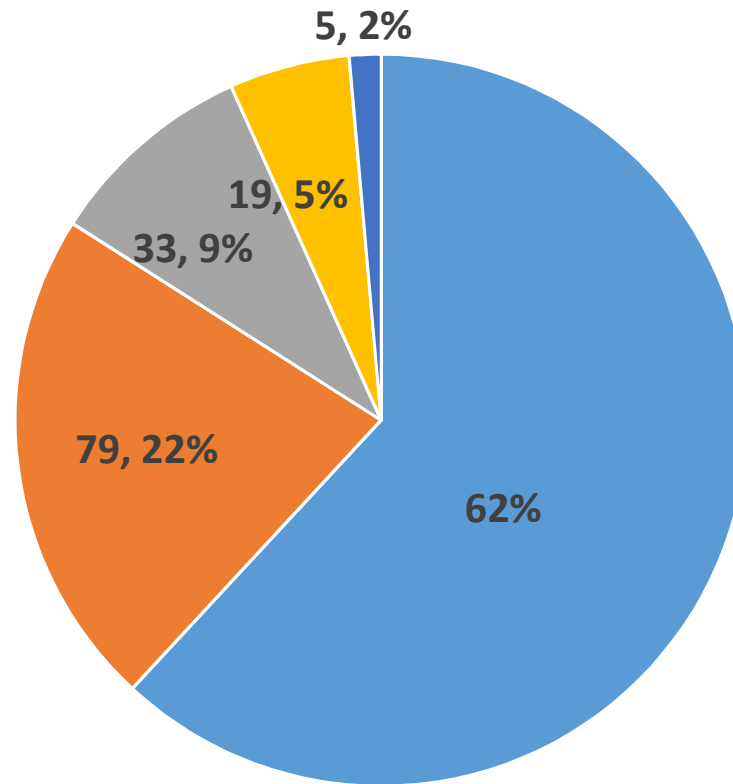
Count of E) What degree program are you pursuing now?



Count of F) What subject area are you currently pursuing?



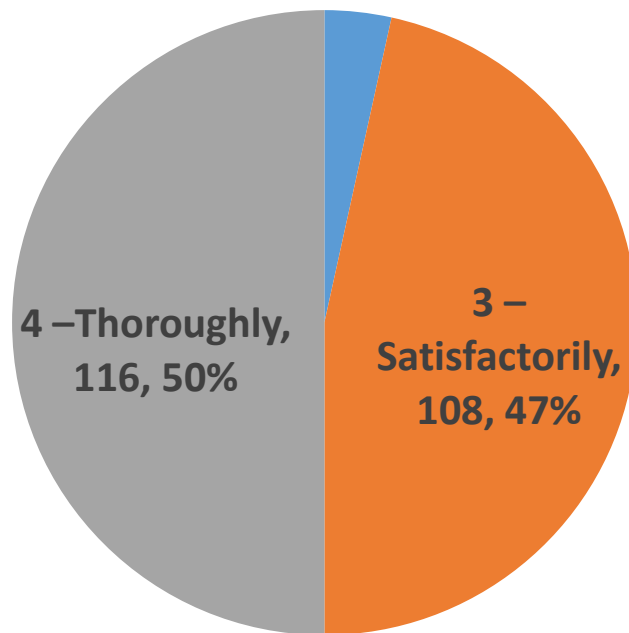
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



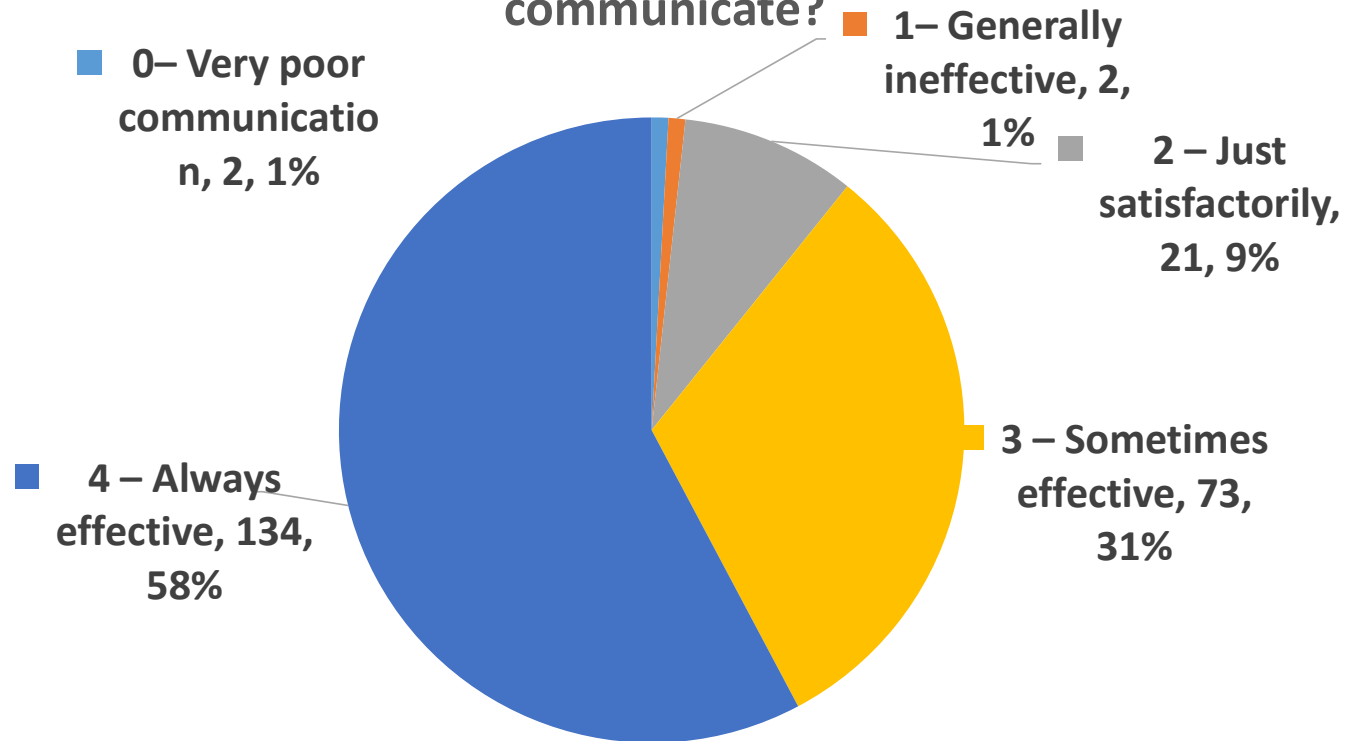

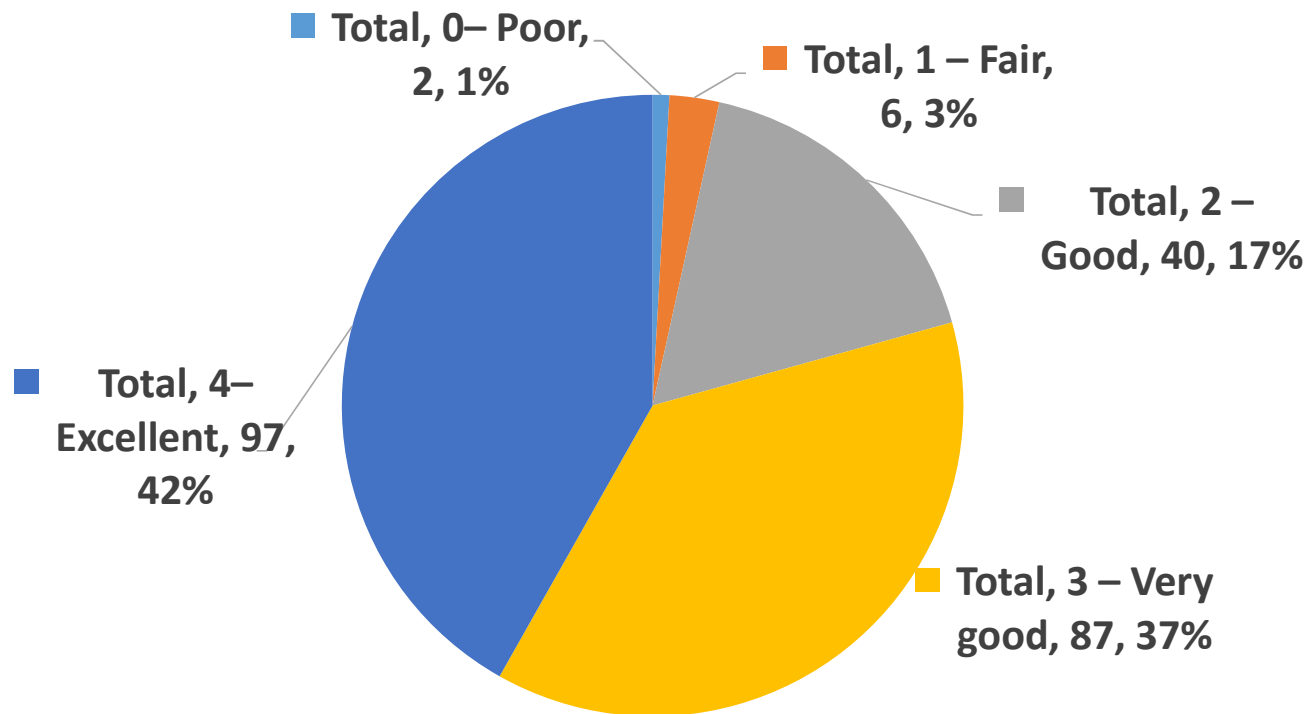

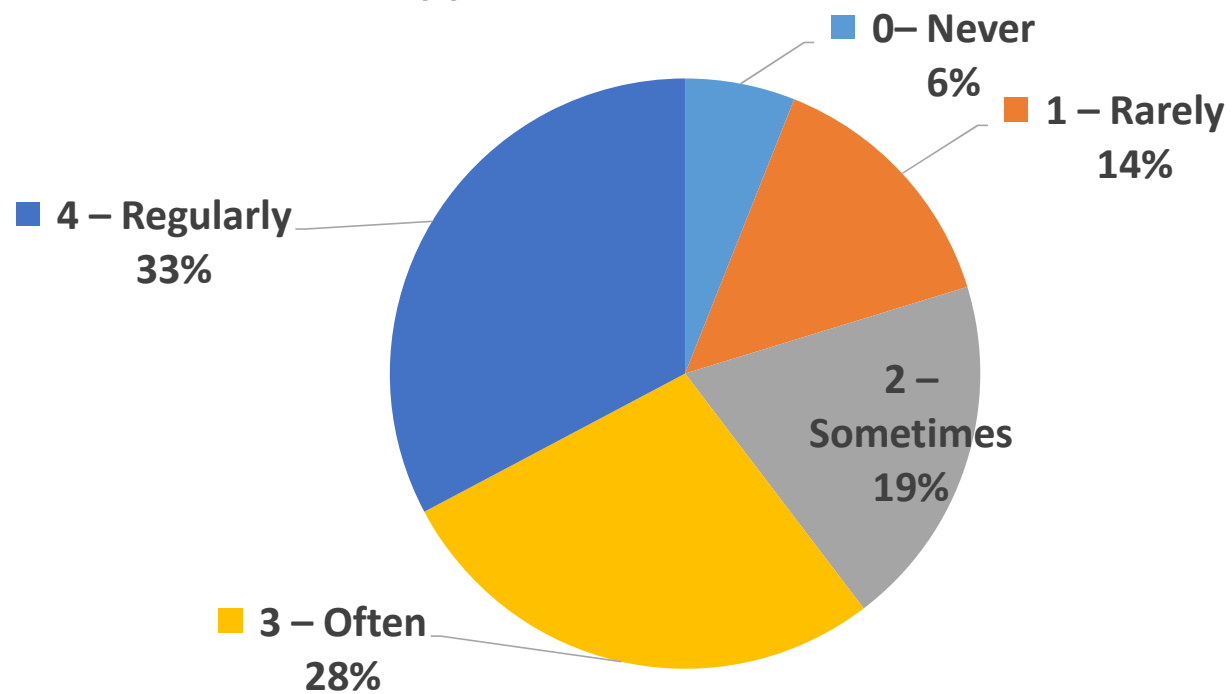

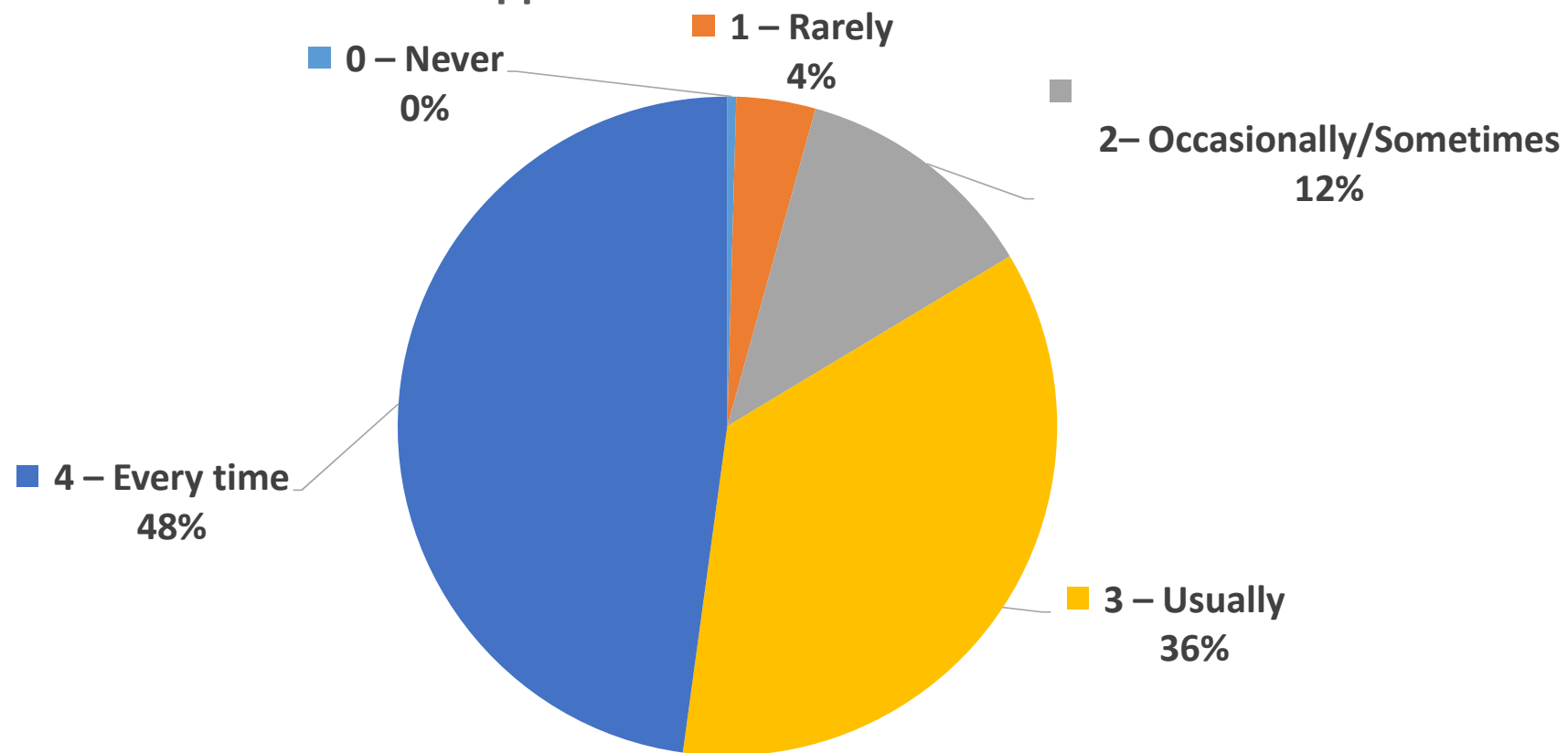

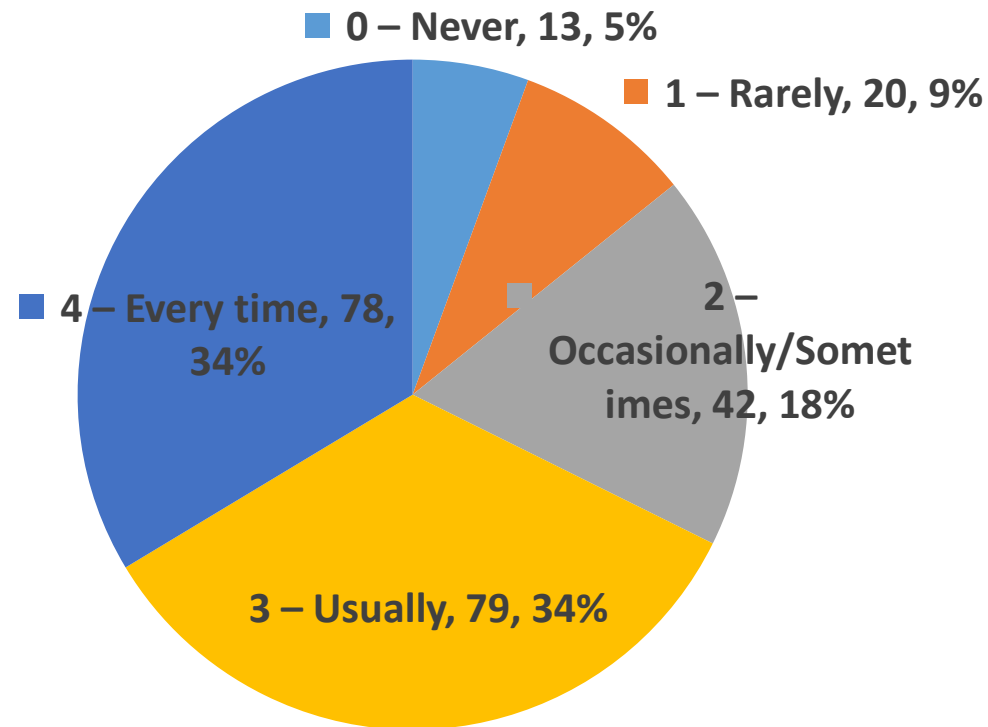

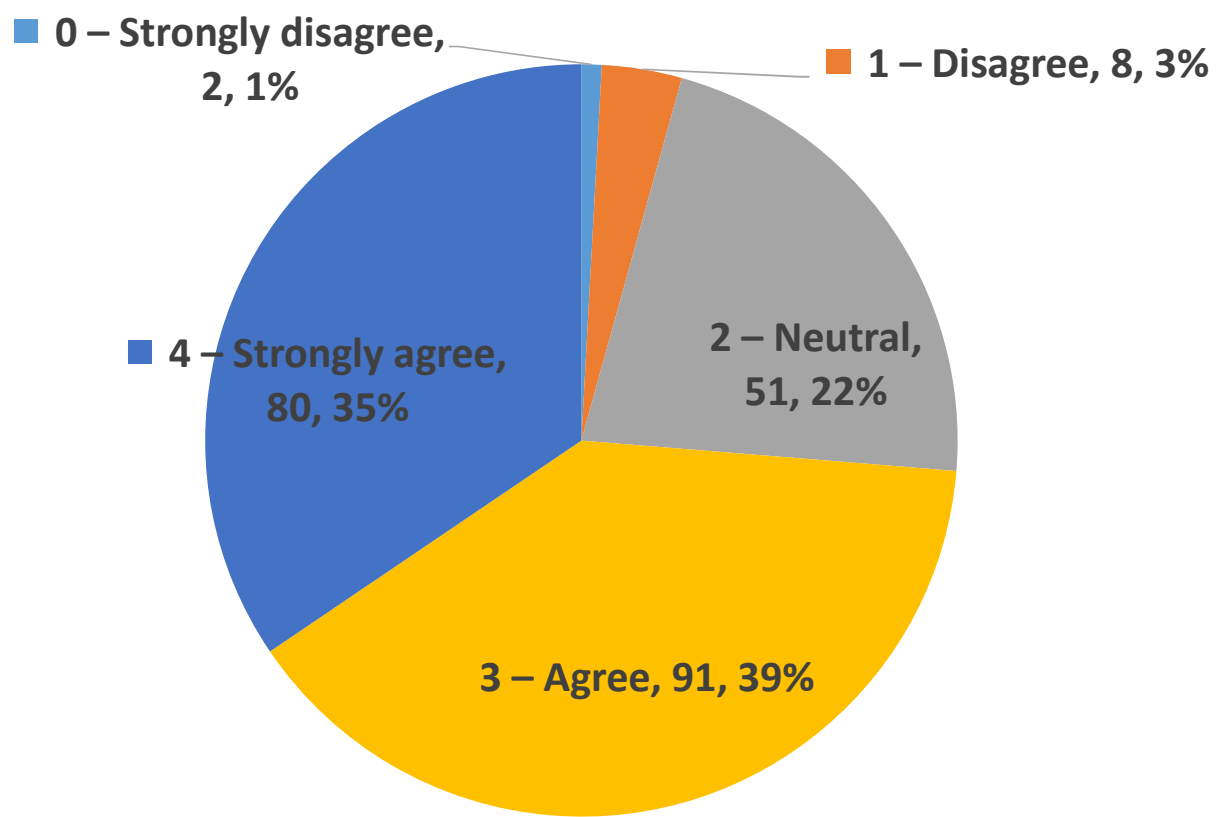

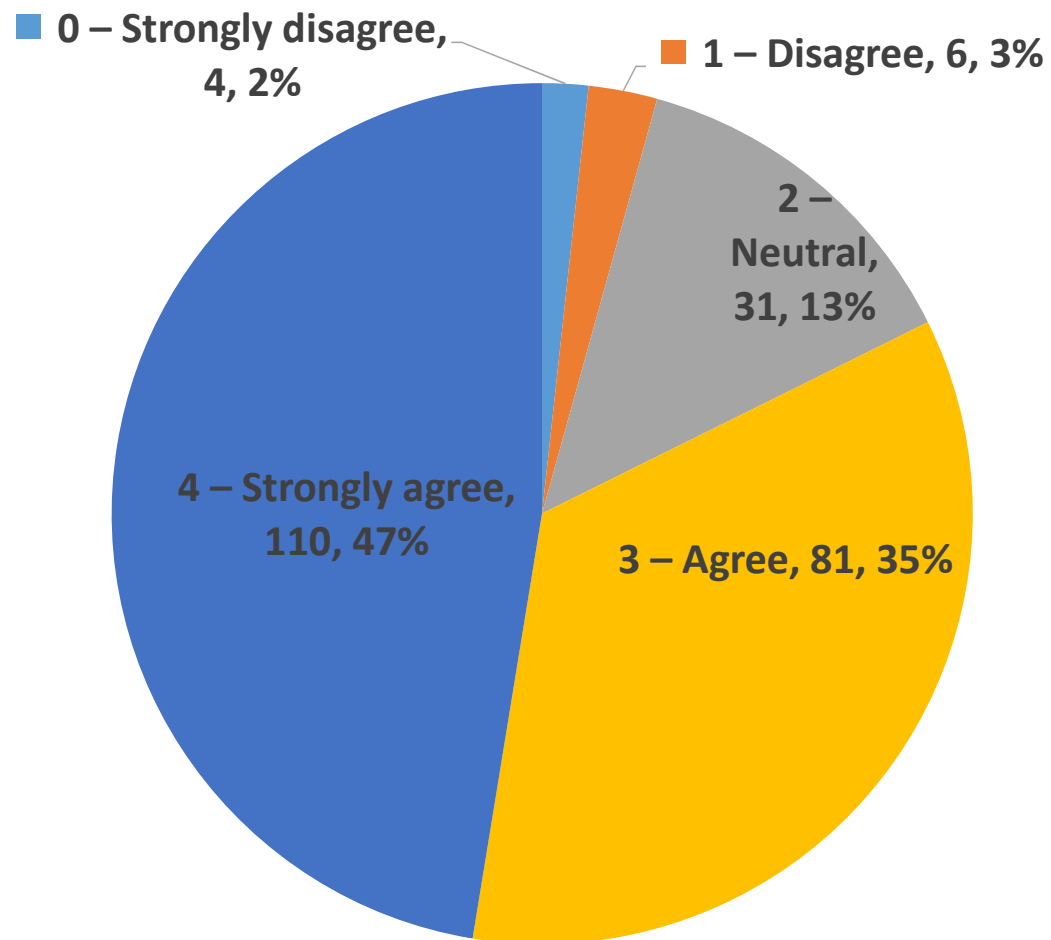

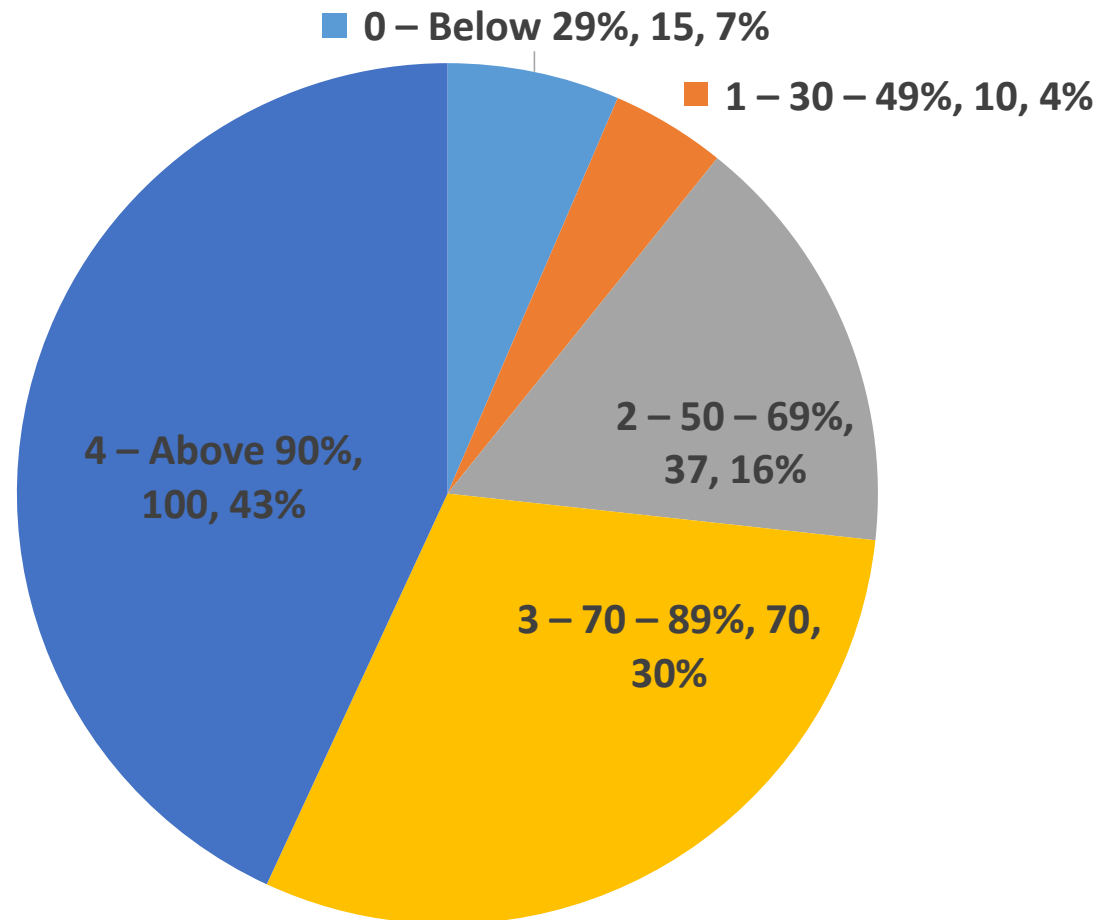
