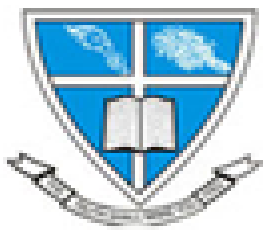

About GAD TLC of MHRD

“Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning Centre” is a centre of MHRD under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Training (PMMNMTT) of the MHRD, Govt. of India. The objectives of the Teaching Learning Centre are to prepare Modern age teachers.
