



# Eye openers: A Service Learning Initiative With the Blind

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The UB funded Service-Learning project of Dr. Justin R Nayagam entitled "Eye Openers: A Service Learning Initiative With the Blind" Phase III is in progress. Major achievements include installation of a herbal garden in the blind school premises and installation of "Talking Books Centre", library centre for the blinds in UCC library with an



initial collection of 146 Malayalam novels and subject books. Mr Kevin Henderson (Program Officer, UBCHEA) inaugurated the herbal garden and the Principal handed over the talking books collection to the Librarian.

Embracing Technology: Inclining Prudent Minds for Knowledge Enrichment is a project by Mr Cijin K. Paul and Dr Jenee Peter funded by the United Board. A basic digital literacy programme with practical sessions for MA History students was initiated.

"Effective Course Delivery using MOODLE", a two day training programme held this year introduced various features of MOODLE which included attendance marking, assignments, online tests, teaching notes creation and uploading, auto-evaluation of tests, creating progress reports etc. The sessions were attended by teachers from various departments.



The project 'Identification of Risk Factors and Psychological Correlates of Substance Abuse: A Service Learning Initiative' was sanctioned to Dr Malini R., Department of Psychology.

Other projects awarded by the United Board for its institutional grant for the year 2017-18 are "Let There Be Light: Implementation of Instructional Console(s) for the Differently Abled " submitted by Dr Jacob George C(Coordinator), Ms Asha Baby Mathews and Ms. Akhila Narayanan and " Peacemaker: Designing Curriculum and Methodology in Peace Studies" submitted by Dr Jenee Peter.

## **CSRS**

The Centre for the Study of Religion and Society (CSRS) with C.P.Mathew Chair was awarded an institutional project, 'Understanding Alternative Lives: Equipping Students for a Peaceful Co-existence', by the UBCHEA in July 2016.

CSRS also organised the third T.O Abdulla Endowment lecture series; the Speakers were Prof. Dr. Sunil P. Ilayidom, Sri. V.K. Sreeraman and Sri. Santhosh George Kulangara.



Three day workshop on the project theme 'Conceptualization and Interview Skills' was organized to make students understand the different dimensions of the concept and to improve their research and interviewing skills outside the campus at AELI (Aluva English Learning Institute) hills from November 4–6, 2016.



Interviews with ten alternative lives from various walks of life as part of the interview were executed. Three mock interviews were conducted and five little magazines were published. As part of the project, the CSRS team visited institutions such as Anjappam, Akasapparavakal and carried out activities such as music therapy, hands on training on sowing of germinated paddy seeds and kathakali demonstration.

### **REACHING OUT**

The students of the Department of Zoology undertook activities aimed at community welfare along environment conservation lines. Health surveys were conducted to combat monsoon epidemic diseases in nearby communities. They got engaged in a service learning programme where they visited homes in nearby Veliyathunad Harijan Colony and surveyed the health status, potable water quality, waste management strategies adopted and diseases encountered. The water quality samples were taken and tested by students in the Department laboratory. The students educated the families towards good hygiene practices so as to avoid monsoon epidemic diseases and other water borne sicknesses.



The Department of Psychology initiated an extension programme 'Enabling the Enablers' for members of Sasthra Sahithya Parishath (SSP) with the intention of identifying and helping those in need of mental health services in the community. The faculty members of the Department engaged classes on mental health issues to enable the members of the SSP gain awareness regarding the chief mental health concerns of the society and the need to seek appropriate intervention at the earliest.

Classes for NGPE are conducted by the faculty of the Department of Physics with the support of Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT), outside the working hours (saturdays and holidays) for UG students of our college and neighboring colleges. Interactive workshops are held by the faculty of the Department for teachers from other colleges in selected topics of theoretical physics. An Interactive workshop for higher secondary school teachers in Physics was also held in July 2017.

Students of the Department of Economics visited old age home run by Welfare Association Trust, Veliyathunadu on 2 October, 2016 and distributed new cloths worth ₹15,000.00.


#### **ZOOLOGY**


