After the Covid-19 lock-down, college activities resumed and online classes were started. End-semester examinations were conducted successfully. Online teaching and learning brought many unprecedented problems before us. Students without online access, due to lack of gadgets or data connectivity, were the worst affected. The College, with the help of Old Students' Association, gathered funds to provide mobile phones to needy students with the "Gandhimavu Challenge". Also, we are working on providing free data for those students who cannot afford it. Another programme envisaged to reduce the digital divide is to arrange laptop computers in the college for the use of students in their project, seminar preparation etc., on rental basis. The College has good faith in the continuing support and generosity of its old students and well-wishers and hopes that all these challenges can be met

adequately.

Covid-19 pandemic has made the task of organizing seminars easier. All the seminars, or more precisely, webinars, are online. All the departments and some clubs and societies enthusiastically organized webinars on various topics with very eminent and well known experts as invited speakers, immensely benefitting students and the teaching community, within the college and outside. The number of participants was also large because of the convenience of attending the webinars from the safety of one's own place.

The College has lots of dream projects to fulfill as part of our Centenary. One of them is to upgrade our library to an international standard and to become a knowledge hub in this part of the country. The preliminary part of the work has been done with the help of Habitat Technology Group, headed by People's Architect, Padmasri Dr. G. Shankar. A multi-storeyed building, adjoining the existing nostalgic library building, having all the modern facilities, is in the offing.

By way of innovation, we have designed a light board to facilitate online classes, with a plan to record 100 such classes on various topics in this centenary year, to benefit students as well as the public. We have also constructed a near sound-proof recording studio for online classes, at professional standards.

The College has been sanctioned a new B.VoC. degree programme in Advanced Multi-Sports and Fitness Training and a Bachelor degree course in Sports Management. Let's hope for a better future in the post pandemic period with lots of new pedagogic practices and new areas of knowledge.






World Ozone Day was observed with an online awareness session on "Climate Change" by Prof. K V Dayal, Organic Farming Course Coordinator, MG University.




